

Civic Commons License – v0.1

For the Tuvalu Sovereign Vision Project & Digital Archipelago

This license grants permission to use, build upon, and adapt the licensed works under the following conditions:

1. Permitted Uses

You may:

- Use, copy, modify, and redistribute the works freely
- Build physical or digital systems using the licensed designs or code
- Localize or adapt the works for your community or ecosystem
- Integrate with other open or ethical civic technologies

2. Conditions

You must:

- Attribute the source (e.g. “Based on the Tuvalu Sovereign Vision Project”)
- Preserve openness: all modifications must remain open and shared
- Use the works only for purposes of:
 - Ecological restoration
 - Civic resilience and empowerment
 - Cultural continuity
 - Humanitarian or educational benefit

3. Prohibited Uses

You may not:

- Use the works for military, surveillance, extractive, or coercive purposes
- Privatize or restrict public access to derivative works
- Claim exclusive rights, trademarks, or patents on the licensed content or adaptations
- Use the works in ways that cause ecological or cultural harm

4. Optional Stewardship

You are encouraged to:

- Register your implementation with the Digital Archipelago Registry
- Document and share your adaptations with the global community
- Maintain a public or ritual record of the system’s lifecycle and use

5. License Scope

This license applies to:

- All associated design files, schematics, diagrams, CADs, hardware layouts
- Software, firmware, code modules, and interfaces (e.g. Guardian, Arbor terminals)
- Rituals, naming systems, civic frameworks, and cultural integration templates
- Infrastructure units including: Vai Tapu, Vai Koko, Te L■ o Te Namo, Coral Cradles, Mirror Vaults, and others

6. Legal Framework

This license is inspired by open hardware and ethical software licenses, and is governed by principles of the Civic Commons. It may be enforced or revoked in cases of severe violation, in accordance with community and Guardian oversight.
